## FORMAT:

**Abstracts** are limited to five A4-sized pages including text, figures and tables.

**Margins** (top, bottom, left, right): 25 mm.

**Title:** upper and lower case, left justified; Times New Roman, 14 pt bold.

**Author's names:** upper and lower case, left justified, first name first, surname last, Times New Roman, 12 pt.

**Affiliation:** upper and lower case, left justified, Times New Roman, 10 pt.; numbered superscripts should be used to indicate the affiliation of each author.

**Abstract** should be 150-200 words, single-spaced text, Times New Roman 12 pt.

**Keywords:** not more than 7 words, single-spaced text, Times New Roman 12 pt.

**Main text:** single-spaced text, Times New Roman 12 pt.

**References:** alignment justified, Times New Roman, 10 pt.

**References to the literature** are given in the text in parentheses indicating the author's surname, which corresponds to the list of references. For example: (Tolkachev, 2014).

**Illustrations:** jpeg, .tiff, resolution not less than 300 dpi.

**Text file:** extension .doc or .rtf. The file names must match the first author's surname, for example: Ivanov\_text.doc.
