

#### Показатели оценивания

Верно решенное задание оценивается в 1 балл, максимальный балл за верное выполнение всех заданий теста -25 баллов. Минимальный проходной балл -11, что соответствует минимальному порогу для выставления отметки «удовлетворительно».

11-15 баллов – «удовлетворительно»

16-20 баллов – «хорошо»

21-25 баллов – «отлично»
